Nine O'Clock Interpolation – Page 1 of 4

RW1a The stations of the Required Parts and the Altar must be arranged as on Diagram One or as close to it as the room permits.

GI0312 If used, the candles should be arranged about and to East of Altar as shown in Diagram One.

GI0314 If used, National flag and Chapter banner are placed as in Diagram One.

GI0316 A gavel should be on the pedestal at the station of the Master Councilor.

GI0318 Only the Holy Bible and school books must be placed on the Altar.

GI0319 If desired, only an Altar cloth, Bible marker, and flowers may be added.

RW1a1 Open Bible must be lying near center of Altar.

RW1a2 School books are lying on Northeast corner of Altar.

GI0320 If flowers are used, they should be placed around Holy Bible, not on it.

GI0321 If Bible marker is used, the DeMolay emblem upon it, if any, should face toward the West side of Altar whether Bible is open or closed.

GI0323 If DeMolay emblem is on Altar cloth, it should be on the West side.

GI0402 No person shall pass between Altar and East except when Ritual requires it.

GI0404 All floor movements should be made in a clockwise direction except when specifically noted otherwise.

0207 All lights except the candles are dimmed.

RW1b Parts are seated in respective stations at beginning of ceremony.

GI0421 MC stands when speaking.

0215 MC: + * * * (3 raps) +

0216 All stand.

0217 MC: + Brother Chaplain... +

GI0420 Chaplain faces MC.

GI0427 When Marshal conducts an Officer, he shall use his right arm and hand to take hold of Officer's left forearm and wrist as in Figure Two.

GI029 If Marshal carries baton, one end of baton should be in his left hand, the other end should be tucked under his left arm as in Figure Four.

- 0219 As Chaplain and Marshal leave stations all Active DeMolays in East and the SC and JC descend to floor level.
- 0220 Marshal and Chaplain halt at point J.
- 0220 Marshal takes one step further North...
- 0220 ...both face East.
- 0221 Chaplain takes one step toward Altar...
- 0221 ...simultaneously Marshal takes one step backward away from Altar.
- 0225 Active DeMolays except Marshal kneel in unison as Chaplain kneels.
- G0431 During prayers all Active DeMolays (except Chaplain and Marshal) kneel facing Altar as in Figure Three.
- FIG 5 Chaplain kneels on both knees...
- FIG 5 ...places both hands palm down on Holy Bible...
- FIG 5 ...body erect and head slightly turned up...
- FIG 5 ...eyes may be open or closed.
- 0301 Active DeMolays rise in unison as Chaplain rises.
- 0234 Lights are raised to full.
- 0301 Chaplain takes one step backward away from Altar.

- 0302 ...simultaneously Marshal takes one step forward.
- 0302 Both face North.
- 0303 Chaplain takes one step forward to Marshal's side.
- GI0427 When Marshal conducts an Officer, he shall use his right arm and hand to take hold of Officer's left forearm and wrist as in Figure Two.
- GI029 If Marshal carries baton, one end of baton should be in his left hand, the other end should be tucked under his left arm as in Figure Four.
- 0303 Chaplain, conducted by Marshal, moves J K V Z...
- 0304 ...Chaplain crosses in front of Marshal...
- 0304 ...moves X, stands facing his station.
- 0304 Marshal moves Z X.
- 0305 Chaplain and Marshal simultaneously face West.
- 0306 As Chaplain and Marshal leave Altar all Active DeMolays who were in the East and SC and JC return to daises.
- 0308 MC: + * (rap) +
- 0309 All sit down.
